### Self-paced Online Modules Designed to help meet the Recertification Requirement for Earning 20 hours of PD in Teaching Students with Disabilities

Effective July 1, 2014, **ALL** individuals applying for recertification in Florida are required to earn 20 in-service credits or 1 semester hour in instructing students with disabilities (SWD). This requirement is included within the 120 in-service credit or six hours of college credit required for recertification. **The following self-paced online modules are available to help you earn points towards this requirement. Register on MyPGS.**

Note these courses are provided through [Professional Development Alternatives \(PDA\)](#). The PDA online modules began in 2003, with a partnership among the Florida Department of Education, Bureau of Exceptional Education and Student Services and the Bureau of Educator Certification. The modules continue to be funded by the Florida Department of Education, Bureau of Exceptional Education and Student Services and are coordinated by the Florida Diagnostic and Learning Resources System (FDLRS) Administration Project and the nineteen FDLRS associate centers, in collaboration with the Florida Center for Interactive Media at Florida State University.
