A Resolution of the School Board of Volusia County, Florida, expressing support for the Town of Pierson's grant application for a feasibility study for sidewalk construction on local roads.

WHEREAS, Volusia County School District staff has participated in the TPO's Bicycle Pedestrian Safety Studies around area elementary and middle schools; and


WHEREAS, the School Board of Volusia County desires to support the multiagency effort to provide safe and alternative modes of transportation;





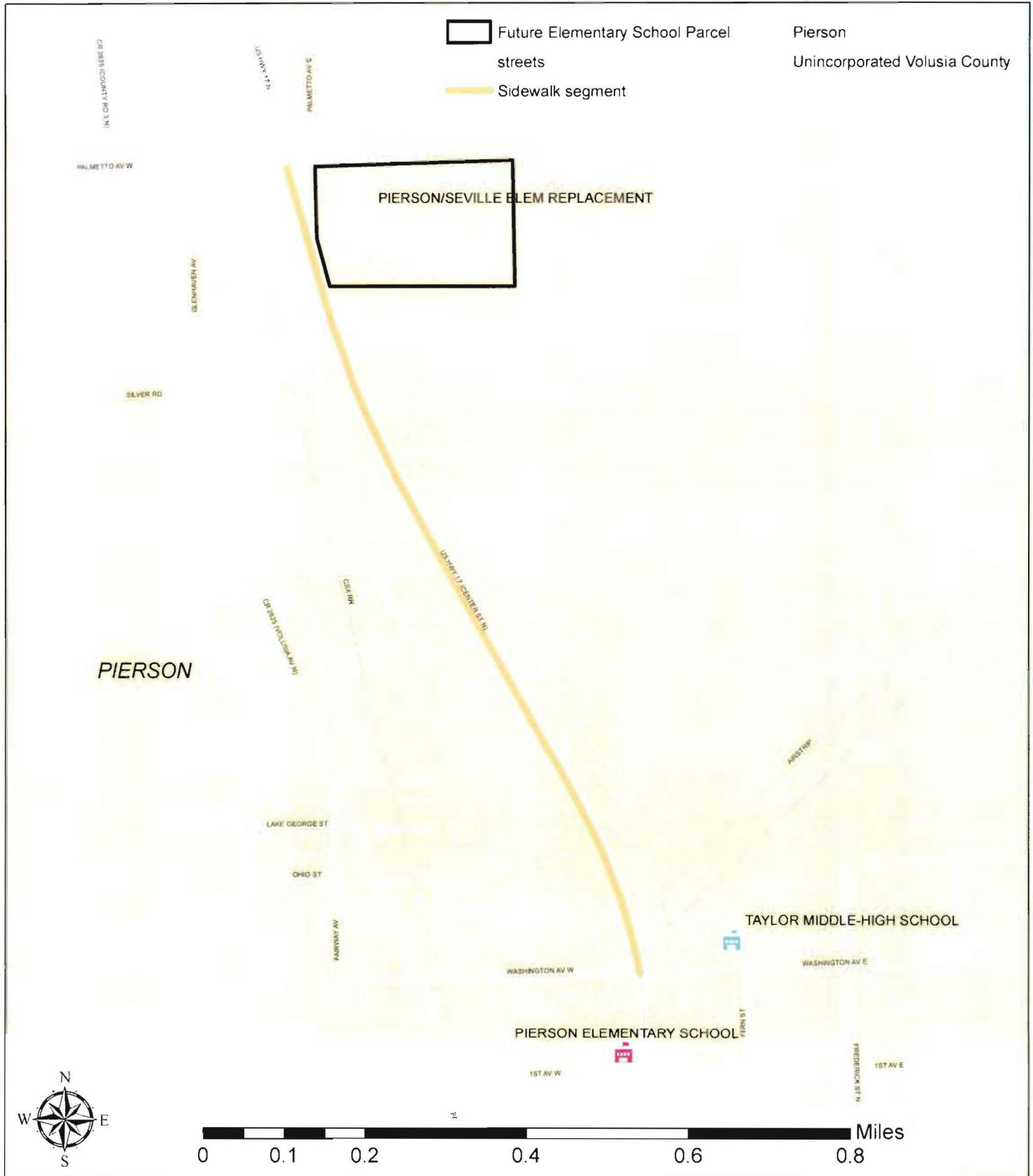
