

Safety and Security

As we embark on another exciting year at Campbell Middle, the safety of our students remains our top priority. In accordance with district and state requirements, Campbell has a fully implemented, comprehensive safety and security plan. Please be aware of the following information regarding campus safety:

Visitor policy: We welcome visitors on our campus. However, all visitors must check in at the main office prior to entering any other campus areas, including classrooms. All visitors must wear a visitors badge while on campus and sign out prior to leaving.

Supervision of Students: We cannot guarantee supervision of students prior to 8:20 a.m. or after 4:00 p.m. unless the students are participating in an organized club or activity. Thank you for arranging for transportation accordingly.

Driving/Vehicles on campus: While driving on campus, please observe the 5 mph speed limit. Students should be dropped off and picked up in the west lot at Parent Pick-up. Additionally, the bus loop is for school buses only. All unoccupied vehicles on campus should be locked.

Emergency Notification: We will continue to utilize the automated phone system, ParentLink, to communicate with parents for a variety of reasons, including emergencies.

Campus Evacuation: In the likely event of a campus evacuation, Mainland High School has been designated as our alternate site. We will assemble in the Mainland auditorium, and parents/guardians may report to the auditorium lobby to pick up students.

Bullying Prevention/Supportive Climate: We have a variety of programs in place to address bullying and build a supportive climate that best supports student learning. Your child's guidance counselor or House Leader is available to assist with any concerns in this area. Harassment and/or bullying are not tolerated at Campbell Middle School.

Drills: As part of our security plan, we are required to hold several mock drills addressing a variety of possible emergency situations, including fire drills. Should you arrive on campus during one of these drills, please follow the directives of our staff members. Your safety is important to us, too.

Student Hygiene: It is critical that our students practice good hygiene to prevent the spread of illness at school. Students are encouraged to cover their coughs and wash their hands with soap often. Additionally, we encourage students who are truly ill to recover at home.
