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General Comments

No violations observed at time of inspection. Inspection also conducted in conjunction with complaint received on 3/8/2017 regarding a razor blade found in cheese stick during the 6th grade period lunch time at approximately 11:20 am 02/24/2017.

A foreign object was observed in a cheese stick by a student who informed the principle immediately. After initial glance, the principle asked the student to pull the object out for a closer look. As she did, it was observed that the foreign object was a razor blade. The principle immediately took the plate into the kitchen, bringing it to the attention of the Kitchen Manager, who immediately informed her School Way Cafe manager. All other cheese sticks were immediately pulled off the serving line and discarded. Pictures of the cheese stick and the razor were taken, the boxes containing the mozzarella sticks were pulled and saved (box # 1 - 65219, 0 00 41322 65219 5, 10026356 10:28, and box # 2 - 65219, 0 00 41322 65219 5, 10026356, 10:27). Mozzarella sticks are received in boxes, with 1 box containing 8 plastic wrapped packages. In house records show that the 2 boxes of Farm Rich reduced sodium breaded mozzarella were received 9 February 2017 (Inventory # 8304).

After the incident, the entire plate with the half eaten cheese stick and razor was packaged by the kitchen manager and sent to the School Way Cafe regional office in Deland for further investigation.

While the kitchen manager tended to the incident in the kitchen, the principle escorted the student to the office at which time he had her write a written statement (on file) and contacted her parents. The principle stated that he spoke with the student's grandfather first, and then mom returned his phone call a few minutes later. The principle also informed the school board of the incident and pulled all surveillance video of the serving line and dining room surrounding the time of incident, in addition to taking pictures. According to the principle, no evidence of foul play was witnessed relating to the incident in question. Video surveillance is available for review. Principle stated that he has been in contact with mom a few times since the incident, trying to keep her informed.

The school has not received any results of the investigation neither have they been informed of any updates to date. No other incidents have been noted since the time of the incident.
