GENERAL PERMISSION & ACKNOWLEDGEMENT FORM

Student invited to participate in the Volusia County Schools PROJECT IBIS must agree to adhere to all the rules/politics of the Volusia County School Board and project rules as stated below.

CLOTHING & ATTIRE RULES:

Outdoor apparel is required: light colored clothing is preferable- you must wear long pants, full t-shirt (long sleeves best) that tucks into the pants, sports shoes that can get dirty, hat, sunglasses, rain gear (poncho), long cotton socks to encase pants bottoms and work gloves. NO DRESSES-NO SHORTS-NO SANDLES! Do not put on any perfume, hairspray or cologne-it attracts biting insects.

EQUIPMENT:

Bring sunscreen lotion, water bottle, backpack or utility bag. Unless you are told otherwise, bring your own lunch, drinks, and snacks. WALKMAN OR OTHER RADIO/TAPE/CD PLAYERS, PLAYING CARDS, POCKET/ELECTRONIC GAMES, AND CELL PHONES ARE PROHIBITED. Appropriate insect repellent needs to be applied at home prior to the outing.

BEHAVIOR:

Students will be working with other teams and teachers in addition to the teacher who brings them to the park. Stay with the chaperone at all times! Students are expected to follow instructions given by any teacher or resource person, participate in activities, assist teachers or other chaperones when asked, and pick up after themselves. Trail clean up may be done each outing. DO NOT LITTER.

SMOKING OR THE USE OF ANY TOBACCO PRODUCT IS STRICTLY PROHIBITED. Students will be transported to the park and back to the school by way of a school bus. UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES WILL STUDENTS BE PERMITTED TO DRIVE A VEHICLE TO THE PARK. ALL STUDENTS WILL RIDE ON THE BUS. Obscene language, leaving the area without permission, insubordination, fighting, or any other disruptive behavior will result in a referral to the Dean's office upon the student's return to campus.

INVITATION ONLY:

Students who express an interest, have good attendance, demonstrate good behavior by willfully participating with the PROJECT IBIS team, and have agreed to the terms set forth in the contract, will be eligible to attend park outings. Because teachers generally can take only small groups, not everyone who meets the criteria will be able to go on every outing. Students who misbehave or willfully ignore any of the above requirements, will be dropped from the eligibility roster and will not be invited back to subsequent outings.
